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### INSET SEAMS

In this class, we will be working to create a pillow top similar to the one below. We will practice mitered corners, and inset seams for the border. The interior will also incorporate inset seams, using a more advanced block.



#### **Students are responsible for bringing the following:**

A sewing machine in good working order, including all cords and foot pedal

Scissors for paper and fabric

A small bottle of Elmer's white washable school glue

Pencil (for taking notes and for drawing the templates)

Starch (I prefer Faultless or Niagara)

A small stencil brush or watercolor brush (full-day class only)

Five fat quarters of coordinating colors (we will be making a block that you can repeat at home if you wish).

Optional: a fine-point chalk pencil. I will have one on hand for darker fabrics, if necessary.
