In this class, you will learn how to create your own templates from scratch, how to prepare your fabric and blocks, and how to make perfect curves of every kind, from semi-circles to full circles, and gentle waves. You will come away with a finished block and the ability to apply this to any project.



Students are responsible for bringing the following:

A sewing machine in good working order, including all cords and foot pedal

Scissors for paper and fabric

A small bottle of Elmer's white washable school glue

Pencil (for taking notes and for drawing the templates)

Starch (I prefer Faultless or Niagara)

A small stencil brush or watercolor brush (full-day class only)

Five fat quarters of coordinating colors (we will be making a block that you can repeat at home if you wish).
