

# Gaslight Supply & Cutting List

## Supplies:

Gaslight Pattern by Sew Many Creations

(18) 3/8 yard cuts of Focus Fabrics

3 1/2 Yards of Background

Neutral thread for piecing

Sewing Machine with 1/4" foot

Optional: Pathways Ruler (If you are not using the ruler please have templates cut and ready for class, found in back of pattern)

All usual quilting supplies including ruler, 45mm rotary cutter, mat, pins, scissors, seam ripper, etc...

Before class, please have focus fabric squares and background squares cut so that we can get right to working with the curves! Follow the cutting directions on page 1 of your Gaslight pattern.

The addendum below has revised instructions if you would prefer to have one large center rather than 4 small squares as per the pattern. Great for fussy cutting!

## Gaslight Pattern - Instructions for optional 1 piece centers

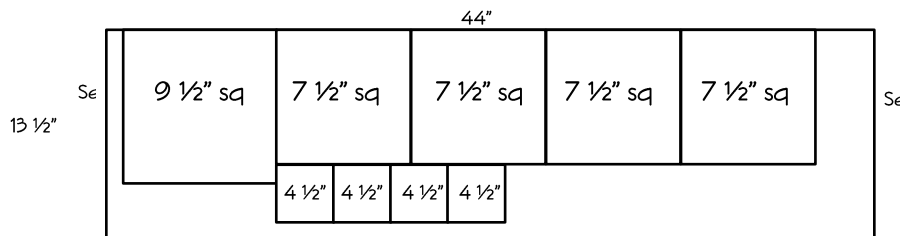
The original Gaslight pattern uses 5" squares for the complete assembly of the quilt top. As requested I have made some slight revisions to the pattern to accommodate using one 9 1/2" center square instead - perfect for large prints or fussy cutting! Follow the pattern as written making the small adjustments listed below.

Yardage requirements are the same for either option

### Cutting: (Page 1)

From each of the 3/8 yard focus fabrics cut: (4) 4 1/2" squares, (4) 7 1/2" squares & (1) 9 1/2" square.

\*For the (4) half Gaslight blocks you will only need a 5" x 9 1/2" center rectangle. All other cutting is exactly the same!



Follow all other cutting, piecing & trimming directions from pages 1-4. The quilt top will be assembled in a slightly different way - see below. There are only 9 rows (vs. 16) since you are piecing some rows as double row and some as single.

## To finish the quilt:

Optional borders: 1/2 Yard inner, 1 yard outer

5/8 Yard binding (2 1/2" cut)

5 Yards backing (Pieced vertically  $\updownarrow$ )

Twin sized batting
