

Albany Pine Bush Challenge:

Your quilt must represent/interpret the Pine Bush in some way:

Traditional Quilters:

- Names of quilt blocks (animals, birds, insects, trees, flowers, seasons, etc.)
- Colors (colors that would be seen in the Pine Bush)
- Applique

Art Quilters:

- Represent the Albany Pine Bush in your own way

All Quilters (*Please note there are some changes in the information announced at December's Guild meeting*):

For Display at the BOTH the Guild Meeting on Friday, June 10, 2016 AND at the Albany Pine Bush Discovery Center* from set up on Friday, June 24, 2016, show opens on June 25, and ends on Monday, July 11, 2016, with take down that same day.

- Quilt size: 144" perimeter MAXIMUM
- Quilts must be finished AND have a sleeve and label
- An Artist Statement must accompany the Quilt with the following information:
 - Title of Quilt
 - Maker's and Quilter's Names
 - Thirty word (maximum) description or inspiration or explanation, *etc.*
- Quilter may offer their quilts for sale, but as is standard Guild policy, 20% of the sale price must be donated to the Albany Pine Bush.
- Guild members will vote for first, second, and third place at the June Guild meeting
- The public will vote for first, second, and third place at the Pine Bush Discovery Center*
- The Pine Bush staff will also vote for their choices

AT THE END OF JUNE'S GUILD MEETING, THE CHALLENGE QUILTS WILL BE COLLECTED BY NOËL PAYTON FOR SAFE-KEEPING UNTIL TAKEN TO THE PINE BUSH DISCOVERY CENTER.
