Twirling Swirling Dance

November 8, 2018: 9:30 am - 3:30 pm

This is a quick project, and the technique used in creating this quilt is strip piecing. There are only three different fabrics used to make this 48" x 48" wall quilt. The twirling and swirling is created by using the background fabric as part of the star as well as the shifting of the fabrics in the lone star block layout.

- be started after the announcement of the challenge
- have a perimeter of less than 144 inches
- be finished (quilted and bound)
- have no uncovered identifying labels

Q.U.I.L.T., Inc. Library: Revised Borrowing Policy

Our library is a treasure for members who want to learn about color, technique, and, especially, new ways of seeing possibilities. They can read about these in magazines and books, watch how they're done in DVDs, and borrow stencils, templates, and rulers to help them get the results they want. (The library is open every month except December, March, and June.) The Library Committee requested revision of some borrowing practices, and the Board concurred. These new rules take effect in September 2018.

- Borrowers may take up to 5 items at once; they are due at the next month's meeting (or the next month the library is open). Six items may be borrowed at the May meeting for the summer (due at the September meeting). At the June meeting, materials may be returned, but the library is not open for borrowing.
- Items may be renewed if no one else has requested them. Borrowers may renew by re-signing the borrow card in person, asking another member to renew if they will not be attending the meeting, or contacting a Library Committee member to renew.
- Overdue items will carry a charge of \$1.00 per month late, payable upon return of the item.
- Lost items will carry fees: books \$20; DVDs \$15; rulers \$10; magazines \$5; stencils and templates \$10. If the lost-and-paid-for item emerges at a later date, the item may be returned to the library and the money refunded, assuming the item is in good condition.
- Library Committee members will do their best to remind borrowers by e-mail about overdue items, in time for the next guild meeting that the library is open. Members who do not return materials, do not declare them lost and pay the fee, and/or do not respond to requests for return may lose their library privileges.

The Library Committee thanks the membership for its generally responsible and always enthusiastic use of the library. We look forward to a new year with new books and materials, and we are always happy to have your suggestions!
