

Registration Information for Q.U.I.L.T., Inc., Show 2011
April 16 & 17, 2011

1. **JUDGED QUILTS:** Any quilt is eligible for judging, including tied quilts and framed quilts. We encourage as many quilters as possible to participate in the judging. In order to give fair judging time to each entry, however, the number of quilts judged per person MAY be limited, depending on the number of entries received. Number those entries you would like judged according to the priority in which you would like them accepted for judging. Submit the judging fee for all items you would like to have judged. If we find it necessary to limit the number of judged entries per person, the balance of the judging fee will be returned to you.
A quilt consists of two or more layers that are joined together. A judged, wearable art entry should include in its design, construction or embellishment one or more quilt techniques (piecing, appliqué, quilting, etc.) in some part of the garment. Batting or a middle layer is not required.
2. **SUBMISSIONS:** (judged and non-judged): Submit a separate registration form for each item entered in the Show, together with a photo to help the display committee plan for the Show. All entries must be postmarked by **Saturday, February 19, 2011**. There can be no exceptions, due to arrangements for insurance and preparation of the catalog. If you are still working on your quilt and are reasonably confident about completing it for the Friday, April 8, 2011 submission date, please submit your registration form before the February 19 deadline. **NOTE:** April 8, will be the only submission date.
3. **ENTRIES:** There is no limit to the number of entries per member. Only quilts made by Guild members may be entered, except for Youth (quilters under 16 years of age) and Antique quilts. Only quilts which have not been in a previous Q.U.I.L.T., Inc., Show may be entered.
4. **CATALOG INFORMATION** (*Guide for your brief description*): Keep description to 35 words or less.
 - (1) **Design/pattern source**--Original (must be a new creation and not a copy of a previous work). If a pattern is used, list pattern information including magazine, book or workshop, project title and author/instructor.
 - (2) **Technique**--Pieced by hand or machine; appliqued by hand or machine; mixed media, such as embroidery, beading, stamping, etc.
 - (3) **Interesting details**—You might describe your inspiration; why you made the quilt and/or for whom; anything interesting about the pattern; a beginning quilter who has made no more than two quilts; details such as an unusual/interesting back, etc.
 - (4) **Special details** (used for hanging the Show)--quilt made by quilter under 16; 2010 Challenge quilt (Going Around in Circles); 2011 Challenge quilt (Paint Chip Challenge).
5. **LABELING, HANGING SLEEVES, PILLOWCASES, DELIVERY, PICKUP AFTER THE SHOW:**
Information will be sent via your self-addressed, stamped envelope after receipt of the Registration Forms.
6. **FEES:** There is a \$2.00 entry fee for each non-judged item and a \$5.00 entry fee for each judged item.
7. **INSURANCE:** Q.U.I.L.T., Inc., will provide security and insurance from the time your quilt is in our possession until the quilt is signed out after the Show. (Insurance for shipping or while being transported to and from Q.U.I.L.T., Inc., is not included.) The maximum for which an item may be insured is \$1000, unless you have an appraisal or sales record documenting a higher value. The amount paid for a loss without an appraisal or a sales slip will be determined by the insurance company, based on a recent sales record of a quilt of like kind and quality. All exhibitors should retain a high-quality, full shot photo of the quilt and a close-up photo of details of the quilt in case of loss. Since our cost for this insurance depends on the total value of the insured items, we ask that you carefully estimate the value of your entry. While Q.U.I.L.T., Inc., will make every effort to protect your quilt, it will be **your** responsibility to validate any insurance claim with the insurance company.
