General Sewing Supplies:

Colored Pencils or markers (optional but helpful if you have a hard time picturing things)

Ruler

Sewing Machine

90/14 Sewing Machine Needle (Superior Titanium Coated Topstitch Needle recommended)

White or Off-White Thread for project (Aurifil Cotton 50wt recommended)

Pins (Clover Flower Head pins recommend)

Seam Ripper

Fabric Scissors

Paper Scissors (I provide 2 pairs to share)

Rotary Cutter

Cutting Mat

Fabric Requirements and Pre Cutting Instructions:

For a quilt that finishes at 52 ½" x 60":

2 yards solid fabric: This fabric will be used for the background of your quilt. I highly recommend a solid or textured solid rather than a print. Because this fabric will be used with a wide variety of colorful selvages, I would suggest a neutral fabric such as white, off white, tan, black, navy or gray.

Prior to class, precut your background fabric as follows:

Cut 14 strips 4 ½" x WOF.

From strips, cut (112) 4 ½" squares. Cut at the diagonal to create 224 triangles.

****If you do not intend to make a quilt with these blocks, know that each block requires 4 precut triangles of background fabric and plan accordingly. For example, a pillow with a 3 x 3 block layout would require 36 triangles of background fabric.*

Selvages: Bring a wide assortment of selvages and be prepared to trade for colors! It is best to collect selvages that are primarily monochromatic. *Selvages must measure at least 4" long. Selvages should include at least ½" of the fabric beyond the selvage, up to an inch is optimal.*

Block foundations will be provided at class.
